

Dear Senator Kennedy:

First, I would like to offer my belated congratulations to you for your election to the Senate. I am very pleased to have you represent me. I intentionally waited to write you since I didn't want the important topic of this letter to be lost in the shuffle of your getting settled in a new office.

For many years now, I have been aware of the phenomena called UFOs. You no doubt have some knowledge of the subject and of the stigma of ridicule which is subjected upon those who have reported seeing one. At first, I too was inclined to reject this "wild" idea. However, upon closer examination I discovered that hundreds of our most reliable and respected citizens have reported seeing these objects, and many more who haven't seen them believe them to be of extraterrestial Origin. I eventually became aware of a private, non-profit organization called NICAP. (National Investigations Committee on Aerial Phenomena) This group has been investigating these sightings, gathering the facts with documented evidence, and through their bi-monthly publication, making them known to the public.

After a seven year study all the evidence thus gathered has be published in a facinating report (184 pages) and then distributed to all members of Congress and the Senate. I don't know if you have seen a copy. If you haven't, I would like to have one sent to you. It would be well worth your time to read it. If by chance you have read it, I would like to know your reaction to it.

I am well aware of the Air Force policy debunking and explaining away sightings. This secrecy policy is a grave mistake. The facts must be made Known, and to this end I urge open Congrestional hearings. My feelings are well stated by Dr. Charles P. Olivier (President of the American Meteor Society). "In serving as a NICAP Board Member, my only purpose is to help in forcing further scientific investigation. UFOs have not been fully studied scientifically due to suppression of pertinent data and subjecting reports of trained and reputable people to ridicule. It is possible UFOs might eventually have serious effects upon our planet and its inhabitants, either for good or ill. I have no personal theory to advance or refute. In view of the importance of the subject, no matter what the outcome, I would be glad to see a very full inquiry

Dear Senator Kennedy:

This is in response to your inquiry in behalf of Private First Class Gary E. Stemm concerning unidentified flying objects (UFO).

The investigation of UFOs reported in the skies over the United States is the responsibility of the Air Force. The name of this unclassified project is Blue Book. A vital part of the program is the release of information to the public.

There is no truth to the allegation that the Air Force withholds or censors any information on UFOs. The results of all Air Force investigations have always been made available to bona fide news representatives and scientific researchers. Press releases are issued as warranted, and an annual report on the project is available to the public.

In 16 years of investigating over 9,000 reports of UFOs, the evidence has proved beyond reasonable doubt that all reported aerial phenomena have been objects either created and sent aloft by man, generated by atmospheric conditions, or caused by celestial bodies or the residue of meteoric activity.

The Air Force will continue to investigate all reports of unusual aerial phenomena over the United States. The evaluations and conclusions reached by the Air Force will be released to the public.

The former Chairman of the House Armed Services Committee, Mr. Carl Vinson, as recent as September of 1964, indicated his

satisfaction with the conduct of the UFO program by the Air Force and stated that there is no need for Congressional hearings on this subject.

Your interest in Air Force matters is appreciated.

Dear Sir:

I am a member of the National Investigations (ommittee on Aerial Phenomena (15% (onnecticut Avenue, N.W., Washington %, D. (.). Aside from other duties and responsibilities, this organization has published a report—THE UFO EVIDENCE—which I am told has been provided to members of (ongress. Because I am deeply disturbed by the material contained therein, particularly with the sections dealing with unnecessary United States Air Fonce secrecy and cersonship, I am writing to you for information and to request that you push for (ongressional hearings on the subject. In the following pages I shall try to reveal some of the more important reasons why (ongressional attention must be brought to bear on the facts as well as why this veil of secrecy imposed by the United States Air Fonce must be remedied immediately.

In World War 11, by official records, UFOs paced, circled and outmaneuvered our fastest aircraft—and the enemy's. Observers included hundreds of pilots, bomber creumen, air-base and carrier personnel, radar-operators, and other members of our armed forces. Signed, verified reports in NI(AP (National Investigations (ommittee on Aerial Phenomega) files show UFO speeds of 3,000 m.p.h. on more. Nothing used by the warring nations even remotely approached such fantastic speeds and maneuvers. It stands to reason that if any of the warring nations had had such tremendously advanced devices in 1942-45, whoever possessed them could have ended the war summarily—and controlled the world! If the United States on the U.S.S.R. had had such revolutionary craft after World War 11, the possessor long ago would have been operating in space—not with tiny "capsules" but with huge UFO-type spacecraft. Neither we not the Russians would have kept on spending

billions on outmoded aircraft and rockets. The very idea is ridiculous. Furthermore, no such gigantic development could have possibly been kept secret all these years.

In 1948, at White Sands Proving Ground, Navy scientists and technicians saw and tracked a UFO at 18,000 m.p.h. In 1952, Air Force pilots, navigators and creumen aboard a B-29 bomber saw and tracked formations of UFOs flying at 5,240 m.p.h., and also tracked a gigantic craft—apparently a carrier ship—at over 9,000 m.p.h. (Official Air Force Intelligence report.)

Today, these same UFO operations continue, in our atmosphere, at such terrific speeds that any conventional aircraft or rocket would burn up from air friction. Massive verified evidence proves that some revolutionary force is involved in UFO propulsion and control—something we have not to date been able to duplicate. Occasionally, an Echo satellite, a rocket launching or a re-entry has caused mistaken UFO reports. So, occasionally, have balloons or meteors. This does not, however, alter the basic facts. NO earthmade device can possibly explain the UFOs' speeds in our atmosphere. This was true in World War 11—and it is still true today. Where does this leave us then?

There are basically two explanations for the consistent, worldwide reporting of UFOs every year:

 Widespread and presently unaccountable delusion on a scale so vast that it should be, in itself, a matter of urgent scientific study;

2. People ARE seeing maneuvering, apparently controlled objects in the atmosphere.

Of the two hypotheses, the second appears to be more reasonable and it is solidly grounded in empirical observations. It is also borne out, in enough cases to warrant far more scientific investigation, by instruments. However, the basic problem is to determine as conclusively as possible which hypothesis is correct. For obvious reasons, verification of the second hypothesis could be one of the most important discoveries of all time!

Given the evidence contained in the NICAP report, THE UFO

EVIDENCE, it is certainly a reasonable assumption that the unexplained UFOs are:

- 1. Real, physical objects rather than the result or imagination, hallucination, illusion or delusion;
- Artificial, rather than purely natural, such as meteorological and astronomical phenomena;
- 3. Under the control (piloted or remote) of living beings.

To date, serious scientific attention to UFOs has been severely limited by several factors, including:

- The Air Force practice of implying, through its public relations program, that all available information has been disseminated and there is no need for further investigations;
- The Air Force practice of artificially reducing the significance of the data through the use of counter-to-fact explanations of sightings and issuance of misleading statistics;
- The lack of governmental recognition, through the (ongress and the Executive Branch, that a scientific problem exists which ought to be probed.

The basic problem and the key to the solution (at least as I see it) is to bring to the attention of responsible people something which, if true, could be of very great significance to the whole human race.

The basic danger associated with UFOs is a danger to the very fabric of society if UFOs are in fact real unexplained objects maneuvering in our atmosphere. There is a danger of a reverse delusion—fooling ourselves into believing nothing of any significance is being seen. There is a danger of an unprepared public, and the possibility of widespread panic if an external danger on threat to our way of life is suddenly imposed upon us without some prior knowledge of what has been learned about UFOs. Without psychological preparedness, a sudden confrontation with extraterrestrial beings (for example) could have disastrous results. If there is deliberate secrecy being practiced by authorities (rather than a semi-conscious failure to face up to facts), this would appear to be inexcusable!

Secrecy breeds fear and paves the way for panic, by introducing false fears and causing people to substitute imagination for reality. The danger of continuing such a policy was pointed out by NICAP Advisor Morton Gerla, a professional engineer, when he said: "This short-sighted policy results in delaying the solution of the UFO mystery, leaving both the military and civilian populations unprepared for whatever steps may eventually have to be taken, whether peaceful or hostile. In the event of action being forced upon our government or people by UFO initiative, public confidence in a government following a policy of secrecy prior to being forced into action would be shattered, perhaps with catastrophic results to morale."

Why are UFOs important? Because if they are real (not explainable as a variety of conventional objects on natural phenomena), it is generally concered by experts that they are most likely space ships. Their presence in our skies would naturally be a matter of utmost concern to all nations of the world.

I personally feel, as does the NICAP Bound of Governors, that the following steps should be taken to rectify a very unsatisfactory situation:

- The evidence in Air Force files (after deletion of legitimate security information such as data concerning the capabilities of radar) should be made freely available to any interested citizens.
- 2. There should be a Congressional inquiry into the Air Force's Project Blue Book to establish,
 - a) the amount and kind of UFO information in the files, and whether all significant non-security data has been made public;
 - b) the scientific adequacy of the investigation (whether there has been a consistently objective, scientific study of the evidence, or whether it has been erratic and influenced negatively by high-level policy decisions, lack of funds, or other factors).

I have here presented but a few of the reasons why I am concerned about this problem. Included in the 184 pages of the NICAP report are

enough verified facts to shatter the doubts of the most dubious skeptic and I ask that you please take notice. What I ask of you, Sir, is recognition of the problem, a sincere effort on your part to see that (ongressional hearings are held and that a long overdue scientific investigation is carried out, once and for all. I am taking time to write you because of the tremendous amount of respect I have for you and your late brother and because I know you pay attention to the voices of little people who are without a platform from which to speak.

I will anxiously await your remakrs and decision.

Dear Mr. Kennedy, I have received your July 15 letter concerning the unidentified flying object phenomena, for which I thank you.

You stated that, from the evidence available to date, you do not believe that UFO phenomena are caused by vehicles of extraterrestrial origin.

The truth is, that there is not enough evidence made public by the U.S. Air Force. The Air Force is censoring all important UFO information. I know that is an old story, but the organization of which I am a member, the National Investigations Committee on Aerial Phenomena (NICAP), has collected a great deal of evidence proving Air Force censorship. Late in 1964, NICAP compiled a 186-page, 200,000 word, illustrated report, which was submitted to Congress("UFO EVIDENCE"). I am happy to report that the document, which contains many authenticated sightings, has brought response from many Congressmen and Senators. The overall response is one of surprise, and most of the Congressmen have promised their support in UFO hearings.

Allow me to site a very recent example of Air Force cover-ups. Vice President Humphrey wrote to the Air Force on behalf of a U.S. citizen, and requested to know how many UFO sightings remain unidentified in AF files. In your recent referral to the Department of Defense you requested a report in behalf of Mr. Charles J. Quagliana relative to unidentified flying objects (UFO's).

The Air Force does not withhold or censor any information on UFO's. The investigations have always been made available to bona fide news representatives and scientific researchers. Press releases are issued as warranted, and an annual report on the project is available to the public. A copy of this report is attached for your information.

In 18 years of investigating over 9,000 reports of UFO's, the evidence has proved almost conclusively that reported aerial phenomena have been objects either created and sent aloft by man, generated by atmospheric conditions, or caused by celestial bodies or the residue of meteoric activity.

The Air Force has lost one aircraft and pilot in connection with a UFO incident. Captain Mantell was asked to identify a UFO while on an aircraft ferrying mission in 1952 over Godman Field in Kentucky. Because his aircraft was not outfitted with the necessary oxygen equipment for a high altitude flight, Captain Mantell died of oxygen starvation while attempting to identify the object, and his aircraft consequently crashed. A copy of the Air Force evaluation of this case is also attached for your further information.

Another incident which is often mistakenly identied as a UFO case involved an F-89 aircraft which was
scrambled to intercept an unidentified aircraft which
was successfully accomplished and identified as a Dakota
(Canadian C-47). It is presumed by the Air Force that
the pilot suffered vertigo while returning to his base
and crashed into Lake Michigan. This case is carried
in Air Force aircraft accident records (see attached
resume).

We are pleased to be of service in providing you this report.





This is in reply to your inquiry in behalf of Mr. Raymond G. Konley regarding unidentified flying objects (UFOs).

Literature about UFOs written by Captain Ruppelt, Major Keyhoe and Mr. Edwards is not reviewed, indorsed, sponsored, or sanctioned in any way by the Air Force.

Air Force Regulation 200-2, Unidentified Flying Objects (UFOs), (which has been superseded by Air Force Regulation 80-17, Unidentified Flying Objects (UFOs)) did not order the "shooting down of a UFO." It reads, in part, as follows: "The UFO Program provides for the prompt reporting and rapid identification needed for successful 'identification,' which is the second of the four phases of air defense -- detection, identification, interception, and destruction." Apparently the sentence has been misconstrued and the word "destruction" has been translated to "shoot down" UFOs. However, we point out that the UFO program provides only for the "identification" aspect of air defense.

Inclosed is a copy of the news release of October 7, 1966 regarding the selection of the University of Colorado to conduct independent investigations of UFO reports. The investigating team will be permitted to release and publish its findings.

Contrary to Mr. Konley's belief, the Air Force has never attempted to cover up UFO information. The possible existence of extraterrestrial life within the universe has never been denied; however, the Air Force has no tangible proof that there is extraterrestrial life nor do we have any proof that UFOs are interplanetary space vehicles.

A letter similar to this one is being sent to the Honorable William Proxmire, United States Senate, in response to his inquiry.

Dear Senator Kennedy:

There is a danger that this letter may find its' way into your "crank" file but I am hoping that you or one of your assistants will read it carefully and give it some consideration. I would hate to think of myself as being a "crank" or a "crackpot". This concerns the perplexing stance taken by the U.S. Air Force on the subject of "Flying Saucers".

I am a professional writer, author of a number of books and countless magazine pieces on a wide variety of subjects. Although I have extensive background as a globetrotting reporter and once served as Science Editor for the Funk & Wagnall's Encyclopedia, I have been toiling in more recent years in the wasteland of television. Like most writers. I have a wide range of interests, a skeptical turn of mind, and an insatiable curiosity. I have been collecting information about UFOs since the appearance of the mysterious "Foo fighters" in World War II. But I did not fully believe in their existance until 1954 When I actually saw a "Flying Saucer" manuevering over the Aswan Dam in Egypt. It was hovering at a low altitude and was obviously a solid metal object, circular with a dome on top. After a few minutes the outer rim started to revolve rapidly and it moved off at very high speed. Similar objects...or the same one ... were later reported over other areas of the Middle East. (For the record: I was employed as Chief of Continuity and Froduction for the American Forces Network in Europe, 1953-54.)

This sighting, however, has no bearing on the purpose of this letter. It was an isolated incident and I have never written about it. In fact, I have never written anything about UFOs but have left them up to the cultists and pseudo-scientists.

As you undoubtedly know, there was a considerable amount of UFO activity in 1965. They appeared in great numbers all over the world and reportedly landed briefly in France, South America, and even in Hinnesota. The U.S. Air Force, as usual, came up with a series of absurd explanations for them. By now, hundreds of thousands of people throughout the world have observed these things. A number of governments have issued statements to the effect: "they exist...we don't know what they are...but apparently they are harmless." Our own government has been silent...even strangely secretive...on the entire subject.

(MOKE)

Recently I visited my hometown for the holidays...the town of Perry, N.Y. which is about fifty miles from Buffalo and Niagara Falls...and I learned that the area had been inundated with UFOs during Oct.-Nov. '65. Everyone had a choice story to tell me and a number of people had managed to take photographs. I even saw a strip of 8mm movie film which clearly showed a solid metalic disk hovering in the sky. Since Perry is a small town (pop. 5,000), the arrival of the saucers was a major event. Thenever one was sighted, everyone would jump into their cars and drive out to gawk at it. One hovered over the Perry-Marsaw airport for about two hours one night, apparently causing the airport beacon to go out. These objects were hedge-hopping and many people got a close look at them. I was told (I didn't check it out) that groups of these things gathered nightly above Attica, N.Y. for about a week. The descriptions were too graphic to be the product of some kind of mass hysteria.

It was during this period that we suffered the great power blackout. I found that everyone I talked to was convinced that the blackout was somehow caused by the UFOs...particularly since there were a number of incidents in which automobiles stalled when the objects passed over, radios ceased to function, etc. ---standard phenomena with sightings all over the world.

Naturally, I didn't spend my whole visit discussing flying saucers. I hadn't been home for the holidays in 19 years. And since all of the reports were basically the same, there wasn't too much sense in pursuing the matter. Oddly enough, of all the witnesses I talked to, only ONE person had bothered to call the Air Force in Buffalo to report a sighting. Most people were afraid to report what they had seen...for fear of ridicule. And many people expressed outright contempt for the U.S. Air Force's attitude towards UFOs.

A week agox a UFO was sighted over New Jersey. It appeared at night and projected a powerful beam of light towards the ground. A number of people saw it and they were all astonished and chagrined when the Air Force told them that they had seen a helicopter. (There have been quite a few "searchlight" sightings over the past few years.)

So, at last, we arrive at the point of this letter. Hundreds of communities all over the United States have been the site of intensive UFO activity. Many thousands of people have seen these objects in one form or another (formations of moving lights, low-flying "fireballs", solid objects of various shapes) and they are all sneering at the U.S. Air Force for trying to tell them that they have seen a distant planet, a weather balloon, or an ordinary aircraft.

The Air Force started out by trying to ridicule the notion that strange objects were manuevering over our country...and now this approach has backfired. It is the Air Force that is looking ridiculous. In fact, our Air Force is beginning to look downright incompetent. The time has come for the Air Force to reassess their public attitude towards UFOs. Their present approach of "explanation and denial" is no longer acceptable to the American Public. And this approach has caused them to lose the support of the public.

**ading through tons of literature on UFOs, and all available proclamations on the subject, I am forced to conclude that we led to investigate this mystery properly. It seems as if the toe knows no more about UFOs now than it did 19 years ago. Alien are traversing our skies, manuevering at will above our towns ities and military installations, and we are totally helpless to mything about it. Judging from the stepped-up UFO activity last we can expect more incidents in the future and perhaps even leater numbers of these objects will appear. Public concern will artainly increase and more demands for an adequate explanation will be heard.

over the past few years there have been many well-publicized pronouncements by distinguished astronomers and scientists to the effect that there is a strong possibility of intelligent life forms existing in other star systems throughout the universe. The average American today believes that life can exist beyond our planet. And a poll taken a couple of years ago revealed that 75% of the population does believe in the existance of "flying saucers". Yet the Air Force continues to try to maintain its unbelievably naive attitude...or is it just trying to cover up its own inadequacy?

We know that UFOs have been around a long time. Historical records of sightings go back many centuries. And yet there is no concrete evidence that they have ever made a serious attempt to contact us. We can therefore assume that they will be around for a long time to come and that they will remain aloof. Where they come from and what their mysterious missions are is open to all kinds of conjecture. I do not expect the U.S. Air Force to come up with any spectacular conclusions or out-of-this-world explanations. But I do expect it to stop playing the fool and stop calling baffled witnesses to this phenomena liars and idiots. The average American knows the difference between a round metal disc that flies in total silence and a noisy helicopter. The average American knows that comets do not fly horizontally in "V" formations.

It's time for the Air Force to give the public whatever concrete information it has been able to gather. It's time for officials to tell the thousands of UFO witnesses that they did see something and put to rest all of the rumors that war are sweeping our country. This is not a serious situation---yet. But a few more seasons like the one we had last year will really put the Air Force out on a limb.

Already, average sightings of UFOs no longer make the press. Newspaper are bored with reporting that Joe Doakes saw something in the sky. Perhaps if they returned to Perry, N.Y. tomorrow they would cause less stir. And in the years to come, our skies could be filled with Trojan Horses.

so I urge you to press Air Force officials for an improvement and expansion in their methods of investigating this situation. And I ask that a full and sensible appraisal be offered to the public.



He handed the paper to an observer and told him to write down an object offer rath number, calling but the number and the object as he did



Without looking the point, he read off the numbers and the objects, first point from one to 20; then from 20 back to one.





What Did They See Hovering

Over Jersey?

By JACK MAHON

What was the strange flying object that hovered over the Wanaque Reservoir in Northern New Jersey ail through the night, baffling police and terrorizing thousands of residents in neighboring townships?

The UFO-which is all anyone could call it - was still unidentified at dawn today.

The police of Wanagae, Wyckoff, Pompton Lakes, Riverdale, Ringwood and Paterson all witnessed the arrange, bright light, which resembled a disc, as it dipped and rose over the 15-mile-lang reservoir from 7:30 p.m. yesterday until early this morning.

HEARD OF IT

They didn't knew what to call it.

Officials at Stewart Air Force Base, Newburgh, N. Y., and McGuire Air Base, Wrightstown, N. J., said they'd heard of the UFO—but acted as if they wished they have it.

Both bases claimed a tight lid of slience on the elimination and denied they had sent pinnes to investigate the phonomena. A spokesman at the Air Phenomena Branch, Wright Patterson Field, Dayton, Onlo, which processes all UFO sightings, said early today the Wanaque UFO had not been reported to his office.

FIRST SIGRIFFING

Ptl. George Dykman, of the Wanaque Reservoir police, first spotted the world disc about 200 yards from the police station.

"It was very bright," Pil. Dykman said, "about two feet in diameter and, ha it district over the dam, a reund light about nine feet in dismeter was reflected in the water . . ."

GOES, RETURNS

Ptl. Charles Theodora said the disc disappeared at 8:30 p.m., but returned about 2:20 a.m. It was motionless for about an hour then moved back and forth several times.

"It raced about six miles up and down the dam at supersonic speed," said the officer.
"At one point it flashed a ray offight on the ice. Pil.Al Campana and I drove up to investicate. We found a hole in the ice about 40 to 50 feet in diameter—there is no explaining it. The rest of the dam is covered solid."

Jack Burchill, an aerespace student at N.Y. Institute of Technology, Westbury, L.I., and Richard Scott, Paterson, a student at Stevens Institute of Technology, Hoboken, gave this analysis:

Need Deep Look At UFO Reports

By ROSCOE DRUMMOND

You can't dismiss the possibility that some of the Unidentified Flying Objects — those "flying saucers" which so many people have sighted in so many different places — are real, not imaginary.

There are, of course, UFO buffs who seem to want to believe everything and discount all kinds of logical explanations. But Air Force officials assigned to check up on these sightings seem so bored and totally skeptical that many here in Washington have the impression that they think the public would go panicky if all the facts were brought into the open.

This isn't good enough. Let's not leave the search for more knowledge either to those who tend to accept everything uncritically or to those who tend to dismiss every UFO as just to ridiculous.

The time has come for either the President or Congress to name an objective and respected plan to investigate, appraise, and report on all evidence about what is going on.

THE PHENOMENA have been coming at such a rate that they can't be wholly explained away by the expert unbelievers. For example:



"Did you really spot a UFO or are you on LSD?"

Last week more than 100 persons (some of them trained observers) reported seeing "flying saucers" in seven states, from Maine to Texas to Colorado.

Last year Project Blue Book, the small Air Force unit created to keep tabs on these things, had 886 reports of UFO sightings.

During the last two years the National Investigations Committee on Aerial Phenomena (NICAP), a private group headed by a retired Naval Academy Marine Corps pilot, received 3,000 such reports.

During the past 10 years NICAP lists some 8,000 reports and says that 1,500 of them "seem pretty substantial and unexplained." The Air Force totals 10,147 UFO reports and states that 646 of them remain unexplained by provable natural phenomena.

MAYBE ALL of these reported sightings are whimsical, imaginary, or unreal. But we need a more credible and detached appraisal of the evidence than we are now getting.

Maybe there is no intelligent life on the other planets.

There is no evidence that the American people are timidly holding their breath in fear of some kind of aggressive invasion for extra terrestrials. And even if they were, no good can come from poon-pooning the perplexing evidence which already exists.

We need to get all the data drawn together in one place and examined far more objectively than anyone has done so far.

A stable public opinion will come from a trustworthy look at the evidence, not from belittling it. This is why a Warren Commission-type panel seems to me to be in order.

We refer to your recent letter in behalf of Wayne I. Philipson, regarding unidentified flying objects (UFOs).

The investigation of UFOs reported in the skies over the United States is the responsibility of the Air Force. Attached for your convenience is a current report on this project, which has been designated "Blue Book."

In 18 years of investigating over 10,000 reports of UFOs, the evidence has proved beyond reasonable doubt that all reported aerial phenomena have been objects either created and sent aloft by man, generated by atmospheric conditions, or caused by celestial bodies or the residue of meteoric activity.

There has never been any evidence that UFOs reported to the Air Force represented extraterrestrial vehicles. No such object reported to the Air Force has given any indication of a threat to the United States nor has any UFO exhibited characteristics beyond the scope of current technical or scientific knowledge.

The Air Force will continue to investigate all reports of unusual aerial phenomena over the United States, and evaluations and conclusions reached will be released to the public.

We welcome the opportunity to again be of service to you.

Dear Senator Johnson:

The report of your Committee on Aeronautical and Space Sciences, "Space Research in the Life Sciences" was kindly sent me, and I have been deeply interested in its content and in the conclusions.

The press has been quick to note your criticism of NASA for having organized a division of life sciences. In my own view, the administration may be liable to many criticisms, but this is one of the most constructive steps that NASA has undertaken. I say this both as a research scientist dealing with NASA on space science projects and from my experience as a member of the Space Science Board. This view also is shared by all of my scientific colleagues whom I have consulted. As I have greatly admired your support for science and for the space program in the United States Senate, I am especially anxious that you hear such a comment.

The organization of the Office of Life Sciences in NASA was particularly urgent to mobilize our scientific talent for the problem of exoblology, the nature of life on other planets. This is surely one of the most exciting challenges in our space problem and much more scientific support must be given this area to ensure the success of our intended missions. Without the advice of the new office, NASA could not have the expert knowledge to cope with these tremendous problems.

In fact, before now, some extraordinary nonsense has been promulgated in the name of space biology — for a specific example, the breading of "space monkeys." Such inanities have been widely publicized and have antegonized many informed people, especially biologists, to the point where the serious objectives of our national space program have become obscured in their minds. The Office of Life Sciences now gives MASA the means to screen new projects and ensure that only creditable ones are given the dignity of participation in the American program, for the same sober merit that attaches to our splendid accomplishments in space physics. Whether this office or any responsible authority will be able to moderate the publicity attracted by other silly projects in many scattered installations, particularly the military ones, is a problem that does deserve your serious consideration.

enother example of the need for expert knowledge in the NAS., organization on problems of biology is in the unlikely field, for a rocket engineer, of disinfection. It has finally been recognized that we

send to planetery targets to avoid the negards of spreading earth-life forms elsewhere by insevertence. Implementing this coution requires a well informed administrative authority.

It is not easy to see why the Papartment of Defense should wish to be involved in exubiology and indeed, I would strendously oppose such involvement both in principle and for tectical reasons -- for exemple, hindrance to international conjunction for projects that have a close military connection.

Many inconsistancios and illogicalities must arise from the executive directive that there is no military mission in space. Since the Department of Defense will have to continue advanced programs in space technology and space science for patent defense needs as well as to evoid ugly surprises, such a directive can only provoke well-intentioned efforts at evasion. I hope that the next administration will give serious consideration to rainstating and clarifying the military interest in space programs -- wie, for example, to returning the development of manned space flight to military supervision. It is difficult to find serious justification for a crash program in manned space flight for scientific purposes, but we should not overlock ultimate military applications. Many of my collowques would deplore the fruntle effort which the House Committee has urned NASA to make to send mun to the moon. Thus, a continuing expert review of the capabilities and intended uses of man in space flight would be another indispensable purpose of an independent Office of Life Sciences in the Space -gency.

No one could quarrel with the institution that government agencies must coordinate with one unother to prevent waste. But for NASA to function offectively, it must have its own technical competence in biology, and biological problems must be represented in the formation of policy.
